Overview

The main objectives of this curricular unit are:

- To analyse the dynamics of travel, colonization, empire, resistance and liberation within the South Atlantic and the Portuguese-speaking cultures generated from it transits.
- To define the hybrid space of historical, political and cultural called South Atlantic.
- To analyse the post-colonialism condition within the South Atlantic Portuguese-speaking world.

Content

- Foundation of the geographical space of the South Atlantic;
- Consolidation of the South Atlantic area - human and cultural flows;
- The fall of the Luso-Brazilian empire and the reconfiguration of the area;
- *Lusotropicalismos* in the South Atlantic;
- Colonial wars, revolution and decolonization;
- South Atlantic now: post-colonialism and the Portuguese Speaking Community.

Teaching and Assessment Methods

Each thematic session will be divided into two moments: the first, will be based on the presentation, by the instructor, of the main themes of the session, based on the bibliography mentioned and complemented with other pedagogical materials; the second moment will be built around a collective debate, that will result from the presentation of additional bibliography related to the main themes by the students. Presented orally and in written, these works will be used as assessment instruments. The final assessment moment will be the conduction of a final paper on one of the major themes of the course.
