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GUEST SPEAKERS

Boaventura de Sousa Santos is Professor of Sociology, University of Coimbra (Portugal) and Distinguished Legal Scholar at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He earned an LL.M and J.S.D. from Yale University. He is a leading Portuguese social theorist, director of the Centre for Social Studies at the University of Coimbra, and has written and published widely on the issues of globalization, sociology of law and the state, epistemology, social movements and the World Social Forum. His most recent books in English are *The Rise of the Global Left: The World Social Forum and Beyond*. London: Zed Books, 2006;; (editor): *Another Democracy is Possible: Beyond the Liberal Democratic Canon*. London: Verso, 2005; *Another Production is Possible: Beyond the Capitalist Canon*. London: Verso, 2006; *Another Knowledge is Possible: Beyond Northern Epistemologies*. London: Verso 2007; (co-editor with Cesar Rodriguez-Gavarito)..

José Eustáquio Romão was Paulo Freire's *compagnon de route* and one of the founders of the Paulo Freire Institute, Brazil, of which he is now Director. Professor at the Federal University de Juiz de Fora, Minas Gerais, he also teaches postgraduate programmes at the University of São Paulo, where he coordinates a research group on Education and Multiculturalism. He has published widely on history and philosophy of education, on critical pedagogy and on dialogue in education and was behind the *Projecto da Escola Cidadã* (Project of Citizen School). He currently directs international projects such as "Educating the Global Citizen: Globalization, Educational Reform and the "Rede Iberoamericana de Investigação de Políticas de Educação (RIAIPE)" (Iberian American Network for Research on Educational Policies). Professor Romão has actively collaborated with the UNESCO
